The recent retirement of the Rev Martin de Pyle from the PIM Committee marks the end of one of the longest, continual periods of service to gospel ministry in the remote areas of Australia within the PCA.



Martin joined the Committee in 1997, and over the last 27 years has supplied diligent, focussed and courageous leadership and direction that has made a massive contribution to the development and advancement of PIM.

Some of the high points of Martin's leadership include the memorable Centenary Celebrations of the Australian Inland Mission/Presbyterian Inland Mission in 2012, and the acquisition and subsequent development of New Dunesk in 2019. The inaugural *Tracks: Outback Concert* is a current example of Martin's dedication to PIM for a new season of growth. Following 16 years as a full-time Chaplain in the Australian Regular Army, Martin is currently leading the revitalisation of the West Footscray Presbyterian Church, as well as serving as Convener of the GAA Defence Force Chaplaincy Committee.
